THIS MATTER came before the Liquor License Hearing Officer for public hearing on August 19, 2020 at 4:00 PM by video hearing, on the application of Starship Crumbacher, LLC. (Applicant). The Hearing Officer recommends that the Governing Body adopt the following findings of fact and conclusions of law.

The Applicant requests local option district approval of the following:

Restaurant beer and wine liquor license with on premises consumption only, with patio service.

After reviewing the record, conducting a public hearing and having provided an opportunity to be heard from city staff, the Applicant and any interested persons, the Hearing Officer hereby FINDS:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Staff submitted a packet containing the following:
 - a. December 16, 2020 memo from City Clerk Yolanda Y. Vigil
 - b. November 10, 2020 letter from New Mexico Regulation and Licensing Department, Alcohol and Gaming Division (NMRLD/AGD) Hearing Officer Desirae Griego to the City of Santa Fe granting preliminary approval and forwarding the application to the City for local option district approval or disapproval and April 3, 2020 letter from ABC Director John Vallejos regarding pandemic procedures.
 - c. NMRLD/AGD Application No. 1175034
 - d. August 18, 2020 zoning verification from Land Use Planner Senior Donna Wynant confirming that on-premises consumption of alcohol with patio service is a permitted use.
 - e. Site plan
 - f. Notices of Public Hearing (*Santa Fe New Mexican*, City of Santa Fe website)
 - g. December 21, 2020 memo from Ordinance Enforcement Specialist Jason Sena finding no anticipated substantial change in litter or noise as a result of the request
 - h. Vicinity map

- i. Santa Fe Land Development Code Table of Permitted Uses and zoning district map
 - j. City of Santa Fe Liquor License Request Supplemental Information
- 2. City Clerk Yolanda Vigil presented the application.
- 3. Applicant was offered the opportunity to present testimony or evidence.
- 4. No members of the public appeared to testify.
- 5. Notice of the Application, including the date, time and place of the hearing, the name and address of the licensee, the action proposed to be taken by the department, the location of the licensee's premises and such other information as may be required by the department was published in the Santa Fe New Mexican, which is a newspaper of general circulation within the territorial limits of the governing body, on November 20, 2020 and November 27, 2020 and on the City's website.
- 6. The Application is for an existing business in a location that does not currently serve liquor.
- 7. The business operates from 8 AM to 9 PM (pandemic hours 8AM – 4PM).
- 8. Traffic on adjacent streets is not expected to increase, and business is expected to increase by 7 customers per day (15 customers driving, 15 walking).
- 9. The Traffic Engineering Division has concluded that approval will not create unacceptable traffic impacts.
- 10. There will be a fully enclosed outdoor seating area.
- 11. The proposed location will not cause a substantial change in litter or noise.
- 12. The proposed location is not within an area where sale of alcoholic beverages is prohibited by the laws of New Mexico.
- 13. Issuance or transfer will not be in violation of a zoning or other ordinance of the governing body.
- 14. Issuance or transfer will not be detrimental to the public health, safety or morals of the residents of the local option district.
- 15. The hearing was recorded and a copy of the recording is made a part of the record.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Under the circumstances and given the evidence and testimony submitted during the hearing, the Hearing Officer CONCLUDES:

- 1. Notice of the Application was properly given by publication, mail and posting on the website pursuant to Section 60-6B-4(D).
- 2. The governing body may disapprove a transfer or issuance only if individuals opposing the transfer or issuance provide positive evidence showing that the transfer or issuance would be detrimental to the health, safety or morals of the community. This evidence must be based on authentic, relevant facts related to a specific prospective licensee and specific location. *The Southland Corporation v. Manzagol*, 1994-NMSC-099, 118 N.M. 423

3. The Applicant does not have the burden to prove that the transfer would not be detrimental to the health, safety or morals of the residents of the local option district. *Dick v. City of Portales*, 1994-NMSC-092, 118 N.M. 541.
4. The Application meets the requirements of §60-6B-4(F)(2).

CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL

1. Applicant is required to comply with all applicable City of Santa Fe ordinances.

WHEREFORE, the Liquor License Hearing Officer recommends to the Governing Body that the Application be APPROVED.



The Director of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Division has reviewed the referenced Application and granted **Preliminary Approval**. It is being forwarded to you for Local Option District approval or disapproval of the Liquor License Application.

While the law states that "within forty-five (45) days after receipt of a Notice from the Alcoholic Beverage Control Division, the governing body shall hold a Public Hearing in the question of whether the department should approve the proposed issuance or transfer", we recognize the potential for conflict between the requirement for publication of 30 day notice and the 45 day hearing requirement. Should the Local Governing Body be unable to meet one of these requirements, please send a Request for Waiver/Extension by email to the assigned ABC Hearing Officer listed on page 2.

Notice of the Public Hearing required by the Liquor Control Act shall be given by the governing body by publishing a notice of the date, time, and place of the hearing twice during the 30 days prior to the hearing in a newspaper of general circulation within the territorial limits of the governing body. **The first notice must be published at least thirty (30) days before the hearing.** Both publications must occur before a hearing can be conducted. The notice shall include:

- (A) Name and address of the Applicant/Licensee;
- (B) The action proposed to be taken by the Alcoholic Beverage Control Division;
- (C) The location of the licensed premises.

In addition, if the Local Option District has a website, **the Notice shall also be published on the website.**


The governing body is required to send notice by certified mail to the Applicant of the date, time, and place of the Public Hearing. The governing body may designate a Hearing Officer to conduct the hearing. **A record shall be made** of the hearing.

THE APPLICANT IS SEEKING A RESTAURANT BEER & WINE LIQUOR LICENSE INCLUDING PATIO SERVICE, WITH ON PREMISES CONSUMPTION ONLY.

Within thirty (30) days after the Public Hearing, the governing body shall notify the Alcoholic Beverage Control Division of their decision to approve or disapprove the issuance or transfer of the license by signing the enclosed original Page 1 of the Application. The original Page 1 of the Application must be returned together with the notices of publication. **If the Governing Body fails to either approve or disapprove the issuance or transfer of the license within thirty days after the Public Hearing, the Director may issue the license.**

If the Governing Body disapproves the issuance or transfer of the license, it shall notify the Alcoholic Beverage Control Division within thirty (30) days setting forth the reasons for the disapproval. A copy of the Minutes of the Public Hearing shall be submitted to the Alcoholic Beverage Control Division with the Notice of Disapproval (*Page 1 of the Application, noting disapproval*).

BCD Zoning permits bars, restaurants, lounges and alcoholic beverage sales.

Dear Local Governing Body,

The New Mexico Regulation and Licensing Department, Alcoholic Beverage Control Division (ABC) understands the difficulties that the current COVID-19 pandemic has created for governing bodies to hold public hearings. However, the New Mexico Liquor Control Act requires that after preliminary approval is granted, the application shall go to the Local Option District's (LOD) local governing body for approval.

With that in mind, when a local governing body receives a liquor license application from ABC, that governing body has a few options:

- 1) Hold a hearing on the license application within the statutory time frame of forty-five (45) days, as required by the Liquor Control Act, and comply with all other statutory and regulatory procedures and notify ABC of your decision within thirty (30) days of the hearing;
- 2) Request from ABC an extension of time, past the forty-five (45) days, designating how much additional time will be needed to conduct the hearing in compliance with all statutory and regulatory procedures, after the extension is granted and the hearing is held notify ABC of your decision within thirty (30) days of the hearing;
- 3) Return the application to ABC with neither an approval nor disapproval of the application. ABC will then proceed with the processing of the application pursuant to 60-6B-4(G).

ABC has no preference in the option you choose, please notify us of your decision, via email to the ABC Hearing Officer who sent the application to you, and we will continue with the application process in accordance with your decision.


